Award: \$5,000 | 1 Recipient

- ✓ Meaningful contributions to ACOFP.
- ✓ A deep commitment to service in osteopathic family medicine.

Eligibility:

- OMS-II, OMS-III, or OMS-IV.
- Member of both national ACOFP and a local student chapter.
- Attendance at one state or national ACOFP convention (virtual or in person).
- Demonstrated commitment to community service.

To Apply:

- Complete the online application.
- Include your current CV.
- Add one or more letters of recommendation.
- Create and upload a 3-5-minute video sharing your goals, osteopathic philosophy, and a meaningful event or experience that impacted your community.



Emerging Osteopathic Student Leader Awards

Award: \$2,000 | Up to 4 Recipients

This award celebrates up to four students who:

- ✓ Have contributed meaningfully to ACOFP.
- ✓ Show leadership potential in family medicine.
- ✓ Are active in community service.

Eligibility:

- OMS-II, OMS-III, or OMS-IV.
- Member of both national ACOFP and a local student chapter.
- Attendance at one state or national ACOFP convention (virtual or in person).

To Apply:

- Complete the online application.
- Include your current CV.
- Add one or more letters of recommendation.
- Create and upload a 3-5-minute video highlighting your goals, osteopathic values, and a community-impacting experience.



Finalists will be invited to a brief interview with the ACOFP Awards Committee.
